Delinquent Supplement Inspection Notice

A supplement on the vehicle referenced above was requested from this insurer referenced above on _____ and this insurer was informed that this vehicle is located at our facility awaiting inspection and our contact information was given at that time. As of today, this vehicle has not been inspected and we have not heard from this insurer regarding a pending supplemental inspection.

The regulations governing fair claim settlement practices allows seven working days for an insurer to inspect the damages prior to repair, commence negotiations and make a good faith offer of settlement, if the insurer intends to do so prior to the repairs. *(See Regulation Provisions Below)*

Section 11:3-10.3 - Adjustment of partial losses

- (a) **If** the insurer intends to exercise its right to inspect, or cause to be inspected by an independent appraiser, damages prior to repair, the insurer shall have seven working days following receipt of notice of loss to inspect the insured's damaged vehicle, which is available for inspection, at a place and time reasonably convenient to the insured; commence negotiations; and make a good faith offer of settlement.

THIS NOTICE IS TO INFORM THIS INSURER OF THE FOLLOWING:

1 - The time allowed for an insurer to inspect a vehicle, commence negotiations and make a good faith offer of settlement after being notified that a supplement is required has expired clearly indicating that this insurer has waived the right to inspect, commence negotiations and make a good faith offer of settlement.

2 – Based on the foregoing, this notice is to inform you that we are now continuing with the repairs to this vehicle based on our signed contract with the owner of this vehicle that are fully authorized by the vehicle owner.

3 – Since you have waived your right and given up the opportunity to inspect this vehicle prior to the repairs continuing within the time allowed for inspections by the regulations governing fair claim

settlement practices be advised that you have also given up your right and opportunity to challenge the repairs.
